Job Description:

A Registered Behavior Technician (RBT) is a paraprofessional who practices under the ongoing supervision of a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA) or a Board Certified assistant Behavior Analyst (BCaBA). The Registered Behavior Technician (RBT) is primarily responsible for the direct implementation of skill-acquisition and behavior reduction plans developed by the supervisor.

Position Type:

- Full-time; paid hourly rate (\$18.00)
- Working hours 7:45 am to 4:15 pm Monday-Friday

Minimum Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree preferred.
- Junior/Senior level college student will also be considered.
- Prefer 1-year experience working with individuals with ASD.
- Registered Behavior Technician (RBT) or BCAT

- Successful completion of a criminal background check
- CPR/BLS Certification (training available upon hire)
- Ability to lift 35 pounds
