

## **RBT Internship Job Description**

Autism Consulting and Therapy, LLC, one of Hampton Roads' oldest and largest applied behavior analysis (ABA) providers is offering a paid internship for motivated and energetic students or recent college graduates interested in pursuing a career in applied behavior analysis.

### **Job Description:**

Interns will obtain training to become a Registered Behavior Technician (RBT), paraprofessional who practices under the ongoing supervision of a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA). Training includes the required 40-hour online modules, classroom-style instruction with hands-on practice, and shadowing current RBTs and clients. Full time employment may be offered at the conclusion of the internship, but is not guaranteed.

- Paid hourly rate (\$12.00 per hour with up to and including a bachelors degree, \$14.00 per hour with a masters degree or higher)
- Working hours 8:00 am to 4:00 pm Monday-Friday

### **Minimum Qualifications:**

- Junior/Senior level college student will also be considered

### **Other requirements:**

- Successful completion of a criminal background check
- Ability to lift 35 pounds

### **Job Duties:**

- Complete a computer-based and hands-on Registered Behavior Technician (RBT) training program
- Observe implementation of direct behavioral services to clients in individual and group settings
- Practice running skill acquisition programs and collecting data electronically
- Maintain respect and confidentiality for all clients
- Complete the competency assessment required to become a Registered Behavior Technician (RBT)

Individuals who successfully complete the 4 week internship program will be eligible to sit for the Registered Behavior Technician (RBT) exam.
